

Megintræf 21-23. august 2020

trim-funktioner, man selv har det godt med, men farten øges primært med gode vendinger, kurs over bølger og sejlets skødning i pust.

Henning, der stod for arrangementet, godt hjulpet af sine døtre, sørgede for alle havde det godt. De blev snakket meget sejlads, trim, gamle Megin minder og fremtidsmuligheder.

Søndag blæste det for meget til sejlads, så efter morgenmad og mere god snak, pakkede vi sammen og kørte hjemad.

The club sees a potential in Meginjolle sailing in Guldborgsund and the surrounding waters, that it can strengthen the interest in sailing in the region.

We sailed back in refreshing winds and at full speed. Of course, tried speed and trim in relation to each other, even if it was not racing. The conversation goes past the trim brackets and cushions several test what it means for speed. By and large, experience shows that this does not matter. You each develop the cushions and trim functions that you feel comfortable with, but the speed is increased primarily with good turns, course over waves and the sail's cuff in breath.

It blew up more on Saturday afternoon, so apart from a single cool dinghy that took one more trip, the rest of us went ashore and ate cake before the evening's fun around the grill. Henning, who was in charge of the event, well helped by his daughters, made sure everyone was well. They talked a lot about sailing, trim, old Megin memories and future possibilities.

Sunday it was too windy for sailing, so after breakfast and more good talk, we packed up and drove home.

It was a weekend completely in the spirit of the Megin club with community across sailing experience, age and country borders. We are bound together by the joy of this little dinghy that can do something special, both for the beginning beginner and for the experienced sailor.
